## **Manual Override Crank Replacement**

#### **Sunea Awning Motor**

**Tools Needed:** Helper, 2 Ladders, 3mm Allen Wrench


Parts Supplied: Override Crank, 3 mm Allen Cap Bolt, Washer



## **Prepare Awning**


- 1. Open the awning to the fully extended position.
- 2. Unplug awning.

Note: For awnings that have a SunSetter Aluminum Hood installed, remove the Hood End Plate on the same side as the Motor. See Figure 2.



### **Remove Damaged Override Crank**

3. Using a 3 mm Allen wrench, remove damaged Override Crank from Motor. See Figure 3



#### **Install New Override Crank**

4. Insert new Override Crank from bottom of Motor so the Override Crank loop faces downward. Secure the Override Crank, from the top, with supplied Allen Cap Bolt and Washer. See **Figure 3** 

Note: Reinstall the Hood End Plate, if removed.

## **Test For Proper Operation**

- 5. Use the manual Crank Wand to fully close the awning.
- 6. Plug awning back in.
- 7. Test awning for proper operation.
